## LESSON TWO - ACTIVITY ONE The Animals Came in Two by Two

## Directions:

1. Print pages $2-5$ single-sided on standard $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ thick paper or card stock. Be sure to print at Actual Size. (I suggest using card stock and laminating for extended use.)
2. Cut each sheet into 8 cards along dotted lines. (Each card should measure $2.75^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$ when cut.) Note: There are 16 animal pairs included making 32 cards in total. Use as many pairs as needed.
3. Count the total number of students, then hand out card sets randomly.
4. Choose one student (or yourself) to be Noah. You may want to have a robe or tunic for Noah to wear, but this is optional.
5. Play: Remind students that the animals came to Noah. Half of your students will have female animal image cards and the other half will have the corresponding male image cards. Noah will stand at the "door" of the ark and without speaking, the animals will find their partner, pair up and enter the ark.
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
