## **Directions:**

- 1. **Print** at least 2 copies of pages 2-4 single-sided on standard 8.5"x11" thick paper or card stock. (I suggest using card stock and laminating for extended use.)
- 2. Cut into even quarters. (Each card should measure 4.25"x5.5" when cut.)
- 3. **Distribute** the cards around the room in full view of everyone in the class.
- 4. **Remind** students of the importance of being responsible and prepared. Call two students up at a time. Read a clue and have them race to find the appropriate card and return it to you. If your group is large, you can have three students race at the same time.
